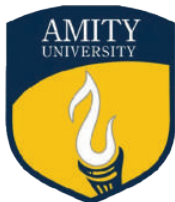

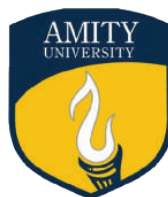

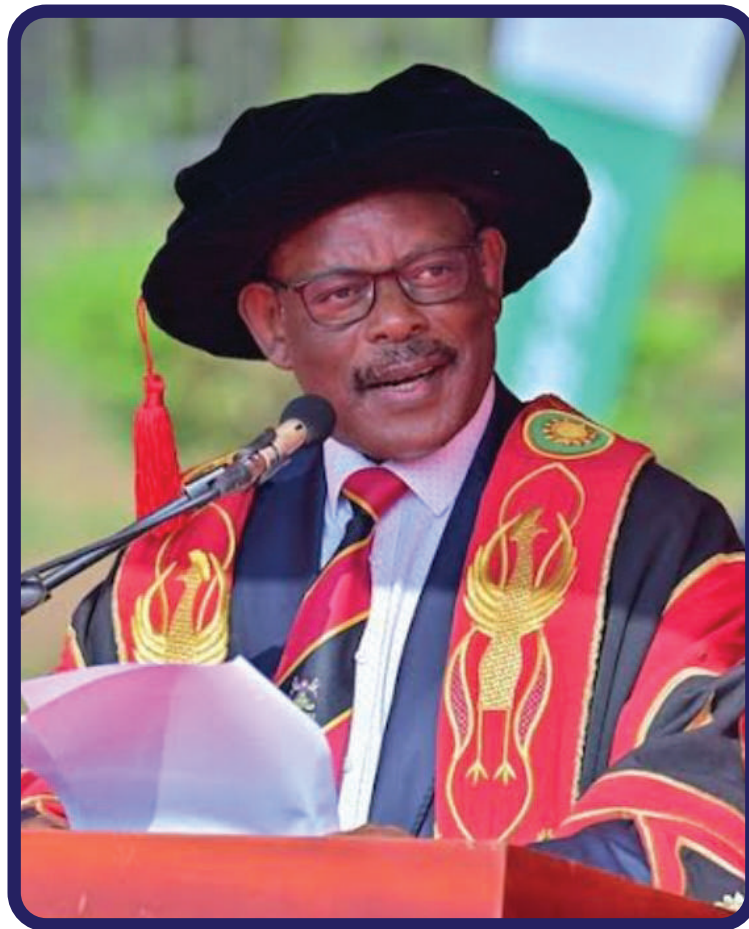

PHASE I**THE PAN AFRICAN E-NETWORK PROJECT****GENESIS OF THE PROJECT**

At the Pan-African Parliament held in Johannesburg on the 16 September 2004, His Excellency Dr. A.P. J. Abdul Kalam, President of India offered to set up a Pan-African Network to connect all the 53 African Union member countries with some of the best universities and super specialty hospitals in India using a satellite and fiber optic network. The aim of this venture was to share Indian expertise in the fields of education and Health care with the African countries in order to accelerate socio-economic development of Africa. The African Union accepted the Indian proposal and signed an MOU with the Government of India through the Indian Ministry of External Affairs.

The government of India in turn appointed an Indian Company, Telecommunications Consultants India LTD (TCIL) to implement the project.

The network was to provide e-services with priority on Tele-Education, Tele Medicine and VVIP connectivity (video conferencing and VoIP among the Heads of the African states).

The approved budgeted cost of the project was INR 5.429 billion (US\$ 125 million approx.). This was meant to cover the cost of supply, installation, testing and commissioning of the hardware and software, end-to-end connectivity, satellite bandwidth, Operation and Management support for 5 years and providing the Tele-education and Tele-medicine services to the 53 African countries for 5 years.

The African Union showed interest in five broad areas of education namely:

1. Physical Sciences
2. Engineering and Technology
3. Computer Science and IT
4. Management - Business and Finance
5. International languages i.e. English, French German and Arabic.

Based on the broad choices of the African Union, TCIL identified five Indian universities to execute this task. The five universities entrusted to provide Tele –education are:

1. Indira Gandhi National Open University, IGNOU (New Delhi)
2. Delhi University (DU)
3. Amity University, Noida
4. Birla Institute of Technology and Science (BITS), Pilani
5. University of Madras – UNOM

MAKERERE UNIVERSITY

Established in 1922 as a humble technical school, Makerere University is one of the oldest and most prestigious universities in Africa. In 1963 it became the university of East Africa, offering courses leading to general degrees from the university of London. It became an independent national university in 1970 when the University of East Africa was split into three independent universities: University of Nairobi (Kenya), University of Dar-es-Salaam (Tanzania) and Makerere University. Today , Makerere University is constituted of nine colleges and one school offering programs for about 30,000 undergraduates and 3,000 postgraduates.

The College of Computing and Information Sciences (COCIS) is Makerere University's primary ICT training, research and consulting institution. The University Council established it on February 19, 2005 by upgrading the then Institute of Computer Science. The College's School of Computing and IT is divided into four academic departments: computer science, networks, information technology and information systems. Our vision is to be a center of academic excellence, leading research, service and national growth in computing and technology as well as providing world class training and consulting services through the school's established sections. In addition to the mainstream University programs, COCIS has a specialized Center for Innovations and Professional Skills Development.

The Center for Innovations and Professional Skills Development (CIPSD) is a highly regarded unit that focuses on providing students with practical computer knowledge and abilities to support a knowledge-based economy in the 21st century. The center purposely delivers training that is relevant to the needs of society. This is accomplished by tailoring courses to the industry's requirements. The Center has been at the forefront of assisting government and other organizations in building human capacity with various ICT capabilities. The Center has the capacity to enroll 5,000 students annually through boot camp & masterclass initiatives, grant activities and short professional course training.

The CIPSD's mission is twofold: first, to provide ICT professional skills development and incubation of new ideas, as well as, nurture new technology-based businesses; and second, to supplement individuals' theoretical computing knowledge and ground them in relevant professional ICT skills for their specific needs. For example, under Prof. Hugh Cameron's guidance and our Software Business Incubation program, the center has incubated over 150 firms, 15 of which have been funded since 2010. There have been numerous spin-offs including, the Kampala startup hubs Hive Colab, Mobile Monday, Outbox, Mara Launchpad, and Grameen Applab. Other accomplishments to date comprise of two published refereed conference articles on business incubation at Makerere University, Others, are the Global Business Labs 2011–2016 (Inter-college collaboration: CoBAMS-CoCIS (Global Business Labs), CEDAT-CoCIS (Software Business incubation), Resilient Africa Network (incubation), ThoughtWorks (Uganda) 2012–2014 and provision of ICT training on a small scale which was sponsored by the Uganda Communications Commission (UCC) in 2013–2014, 2018, the Mastercard foundation scholars ICT capacity building program 2017 to 2021 while the major grant /sponsorship came in early last year (2024) that led to training of over 2,600 underserved and unserved rural communities in fifteen districts of Northern Uganda, as well as the Karamoja region .

We are responsible for training all BIST, and Computer Science first year Students in the CISCO networking course during the recess or break term. Since 2016 to date, the Center has trained over 4,200 undergraduate students

The centre also manages the e-vbab scholarships programmes.

PHASE 11**e-Vidyabharati and e-Arogyabharati (e-VBAB) Project.**

The government of India under the Third Indian Africa Summit commitments announced 15,000 scholarships for students and professionals in africa to pursue courses offered by premier Indian institutions in merging areas. The initiative announced as the Vidyabharati network project has spanned five years and offered certifications, diplomas, under graduate and post graduate degree courses.



During the Third India-Africa Forum Summit held in New Delhi in October 2015, Honble PM of India announced 50,000 scholarships to the Africa. Accordingly, the extension of PAeNP was approved for 5 years with technological upgradation and envisaged to offer 15,000 scholarships. The next phase of project was rechristened as e-VidyaBharti and e-Arogyabharti (e-VBAB0 network Project to offer Tele- education & Tele- medicine services through inter-based web portals. The project was formally launched by the Honble External Affairs Minister, Dr. S Jaishankar on 7th October 2019. So far, 27 premier Indian Universities/ HEIs, approved by University Grants Commission (UGC) offered online degree/Diploma/ Certificate programmes and more universities may be empanelled in future. Also, the MoUs were signed with 22 African Countries to participate in e-VBAB project. So far, 14,390 scholarships have been awarded to the African learners in 4 Academic sessions i.e 2020 Jan and Jul 2022 and 2023.

There have been two intakes so far whereby over 300 Ugandans were enrolled in the July 2020 intake and over 500 applied in January 2021 intake.

In 2018, Government of Uganda and the Government of India signed an MoU geared towards the implementation of the e-Vidyabharati and e-Aarogyabharati (e-VBAB) project in Uganda. To promote the activities of this project Makerere University was chosen to serve as a regional centre in advance Tele - education in East African region. Hence, the College of Computing and Information Sciences and the e-VBAB project signed an MoU in 2019 for five years.

The e-VBAB Network Project set up an e-Learning Centre at the college of computing and information sciences well equipped for use with a modern video conferencing laboratory forming phase 2 with all the earlier mentioned under the e-Vidyabharati and e-Aarogyabharati (e-VBAB) Makerere Project'

Under the e-VBAB Project over 1800 students were enrolled on 100% scholarships since 2020
