A. Vacancy

PhD Fellow (1 Position)

B. Definition of a Graduate Fellow

A Graduate Fellow is defined as a student pursuing an advanced degree at Makerere University, who has been identified within their respective Department/College to facilitate and provide a support role to the teaching and learning of a given academic programme as appropriate.

C. Duties and Responsibilities

- i) Assist in the preparation of teaching materials, direct interaction with students in laboratory, conduct of practical and tutorial sessions
- ii) Assist in grading papers
- iii) Assist in supervising undergraduate student projects
- iv) Assist in providing academic guidance and counseling to undergraduate
- v) Actively participate in research at the Department
- vi) Execute any other additional responsibilities as may be assigned by the Head of Department

D. Workload

Maximum (hours per week) shall be 6 hours of a PhD Fellow.

E. Qualifications and Eligibility

- i) An Honours Bachelor's Degree.
- ii) A PhD Fellow must have a good Masters degree.
- iii) A PhD Fellow must be enrolled on a PhD Information Systems programme at Makerere University.
- iv) A PhD Fellow shall not be more than 45 years old at the time of recruitment on the graduate programme.
- v) Evidence of experience in various programming languages is an added advantage.

F. Emoluments and Benefits

Applicants shall benefit from the tuition fees waiver for the time of their tenure. This is a non-paid position.
